

Staying Safe from Infection in the Junges Museum Frankfurt

We're glad to finally be back in business for you!

Normally we enjoy and encourage the direct contact among visitors to our museum, but unfortunately these Corona times require us all to avoid it. To keep you and our staff safe from infection we have taken the following measures:

- *Acutely ill persons will unfortunately not be allowed to visit our museum!
- *Admission to the Junges Museum is only permitted with a mask covering mouth and nose. If you don't have one, you may buy a washable cotton mask for 6€ at our cash desks
- *Walking directions are marked in the exhibitions and staircases. Please follow these guidelines.
- *A stand with disinfectant is available in the entrance area of the exhibition - please use it.
- *Open doors with as little contact as possible
- *Our museum attendants in the Junges Museum are there to help you with any questions you may have.
- *Our current exhibition is a workshop exhibition, offering many hands-on activity stations for getting involved and trying things out. The equipment and textile surfaces of the exhibition are regularly disinfected with UV-LED sterilization devices and surface disinfectant spray.
- * Our current exhibition "Material* Fabric * Textile" can be visited by a maximum of 20 people at one time.

In order to shorten waiting time, we invite visitors to view areas in the Historical Museum. For families with children we recommend the snow globe "Typical Frankfurt" in level 0 of the new exhibition building, or the 80 m² scale model of Frankfurt in "Frankfurt Now!" on level 3. The family trail activity stations in the permanent exhibition "Frankfurt Once?" are unfortunately not available at the moment.

*For larger groups of visitors / family associations of * six persons or more * we ask for telephone registration under (069) 212-35154.

*Elevators may only be used by one person at a time, or by groups who live in the same household.

*We will not be providing our multimedia guide devices at this time. You can however access the audio tour 'Highlights' with your own smartphone by connecting to: mmg.historisches-museum-frankfurt.de. Please bring your own headphones.

By the way: Both museum cafés are open again from 12:00 pm: "Café Frankfurt" is on level 0 in the quiet courtyards of the museum quarter, and the entrance to "Café Fahrtor" is in the pedestrian zone between the river Main and the Römer.

Please also note our shorter opening hours on Wednesdays, from 10 am to 6 pm

Even in these Corona times: We wish you a pleasant visit to the Junges Museum!

*Please follow the recommendations of the Robert Koch Institute (RKI):

- >> Keep a distance of 1 1/2 meters (does not apply to families).
- >> Wash your hands thoroughly.
- >> Avoid shaking hands.
- >> Cough and sneeze into a handkerchief or crook of the arm.
